To all to whom these presents shall come---Greeting:



KNOW YE, That in consideration of an entry Made in the entry Takers Office of Cannon County pursuant to an act of the general Assembly of said State passed on the 9th day of January 1830 & entered on the 13th March 1833 by No 331

there is GRANTED by the said State of Tennessee, unto

Jesse Todd

a certain TRACT or PARCEL of Land, containing Fifty six acres by Survey, bearing date the 15th day of July 1839, lying in said County, On

the waters of the east fork of Thames river in said district No 2. Beginning on a Red oak Brettton Moon's North east corner running west one hundred and four poles to a hicory in Mary Corvesters east boundary line thence North with her line - and Josephus Coons line fifty eight poles to a stake Coons North east corner of a twenty five acre tract, thence east with the South boundary line of a 100 acre tract of said - one hundred and seventy two poles to a Sugar tree on the west boundary line of Chas. P. Alexander thence South passing his corner in all fifty one poles to a Sugar tree thence west fifty eight poles to a buckeye thence South seventeen poles to the Beginning

With the hereditaments and appertences;—To HAVE and to HOLD the said TRACT or PARCEL OF LAND, with its appertences, to the said Jesse Todd and his heirs forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF James H. Polk—Governor of the State of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed, at NASHVILLE, on the 29th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty and of the Independence of the United States the sixty-fourth
