Wound. Claimant had rode the
horse on duty for a month or more
previous to his death. he rode ~~him~~
~~on duty~~. I dont remember who they
bought the horse from. but if I am
not mistaken he bought him from
a citizen living on ^{or in the vicinity} of
Cane Hill. I do not remember what he paid
for the horse.

The horse was a bay color, Suffolk
breed 7 years old. Sound and in
very good fix. he was about 15
hands high. he was worth the
very best rated there. Some
\$125.00 Such I have no idea what
such a horse would bring now.
