months & seven days, - after his nine
months enlistment was over
the County was in great want
of men & he was prevailed upon
to continue & did continue under
his first enlistment 14 months &
7 days, & was then discharged near
Purysburg South Carolina -

There afterward, as he thinks in
1781. it was after Genl Green
took the command in the South
he served a three months term
in the militia as a substitute
for his Brother M^{rs}. Todd - went
from Rowan County N. Carolina
under Capt James Craig - Colo
Davy was Comdr. - they were
engaged in guarding & protecting
the County against the Tories
& British - were stationed at
no particular place - was
discharged in Salisbury N. C.
his horse was burnt & all
his papers burnt in it - he
has no documentary evidence
to prove his service - but can

he has lived in Madison County, N. C.
between thirty & forty years -
he hereby relinquishes all
