William C. Leech, Commissioner of the minor heirs of Curry Green, to David Hogwood a man slave named Harry, about 40, for \$600. 18 Jul 1850. (P. 464)

Patton Farler to John Farler 75 acres on the east fork of Stone's River. 27 Jul 1850. (Pp. 464-466)

John R. Sullivan to William F. George a title bond. 23 Jan 1850. (Pp. 466-467)

Mitchel Daniel to Joseph Simpson and the other trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church a deed of gift one acre in the 5th District on Barren Fork of Collins River. 24 Jul 1850. (Pp. 467-468)
