TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME---GREETING:

BEWEE YOU, That for and in consideration of the sum of twelve and one half cents per acre, paid into the office of the Entry-taker of *Rutherford* county, and entered on the *5<sup>th</sup>* day of *July* 1824, pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the General Assembly of said state, passed on the 22d day of November, 1823, by No. 249. There is granted by the said State of Tennessee, unto *Joseph Todd*)

A certain tract or parcel of land, containing *fifty acres*

by survey bearing date the *4<sup>th</sup>* day of *October* 1825, lying in said county, on the waters of dry brook of the east fork of Stones River & bounded as follows to west Beginning at a black locust the south east corner of a fifty acre survey made in the name of Mary Marshall Running thence North with her east boundary line passing her north east corner one hundred and twenty one poles to a stake a bunch of lynn marked as a point thence East thirty seven poles to a stake a hickory and white ash marked as a point thence South to Hugh Bradleys north west corner and with his west boundary line seventy seven poles to his south west corner thence East with his south boundary line Eighty poles to a lynn his south east corner thence South forty four poles to an ash and two sugar trees thence also to Cornelius Brandon's north east corner and with his north boundary line one hundred and seventeen poles to the beginning

With the hereditaments and appertenances. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract or parcel of land, with its appertenances, to the said *Joseph Todd*)

and his heirs forever. **In witness whereof,** *William Carroll* Governor of the state of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the great seal of the state to be affixed, at *Nashville* on the *10<sup>th</sup>* day of *November* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six and of the Independence of the United States, the *51<sup>st</sup>*.
